## **Program Descriptions**

### **AGES 7-10**

**DIFFERENT STROKES** (Week 1 AM): Unlock the secrets of painting in this introductory class. Students will experiment with a variety of painting styles and media, while learning about color mixing, blending, composition, and other keys to creating a beautiful painting from the first brushstroke to the last.

**ART MEETS SCIENCE** (Week 1 AM): This class introduces students to the many ways art and science go hand-in-hand, from the physics of light and color to the chemistry of art materials. Students will use both art supplies and everyday materials to create works of art through scientifically-themed experiments and play.

**SHADOW AND LINE: SECRETS OF DRAWING** (Week 1 PM): By learning its fundamental elements, students will discover the possibilities of drawing in this fun and engaging skill-building class. Throughout the week, students will explore a variety of drawing materials, such as charcoal and pastels.

**OCEAN EXPLORATIONS** (Week 1 PM): Ahoy mateys! Join us for a week of ocean-inspired art. We'll draw, paint, and sculpt a variety of sea creatures, while also exploring how artists throughout history have tried to capture the unique power and beauty of the ocean.

**FANTASTICAL BEASTS AND HOW TO DRAW THEM** (Week 2 AM): Unicorns, dragons, and yeti—oh my! Students will use their imaginations to design extraordinary creatures fit for a storybook, while exploring a variety of art materials and techniques.

**LEAP INTO CHINESE CULTURE!** (Week 2 PM): Get to know the amazing art of China and learn about the country's wonderful and varied traditions—some over thousands of years old! Projects include practicing calligraphy, creating masks, and learning how the lion dance comes to life at Lunar New Year celebrations. *This class is generously supported by the Confucius Institute of Rutgers University (CIRU).*

**OFF THE WALL: EXPLORING SCULPTURE** (Week 3 AM): Explore the world of three-dimensional art with a focus on the creation of sculptures. Students will experiment with clay, wire, papier-mâché and molds as they learn about various media used by artists in the creation of sculptures.

**ANIMAL ADVENTURES** (Week 3 AM): Artists have been fascinated by animals since the time of cave paintings. Students will explore the wonderful world of animals through art, learning how to draw and sculpt different animals in a variety of styles from realistic to abstract.

**PRINTMAKING** (Week 3 PM): This class introduces students to the fascinating art of printmaking, from start to finish, and how it is used for both artistic and everyday purposes. Students will experiment with a variety of printmaking techniques.

**MIX IT UP** (Week 3 PM): The term "mixed media" refers to art made with more than one material, such as collages, altered objects, and other works that defy traditional boundaries. In this class, students will create works of art through techniques that combine paint, paper, and found objects.

**CRAZY ABOUT CARTOONS** (Week 4 AM): Learn essential cartooning techniques to help you create your own comic books, cartoons, or graphic novels. Students will develop skills in creating characters, laying out stories, inking, and using word balloons.

**ABOUT TIME** (Week 4 AM): Art has long been used as a way to mark the passage of time. In this new class, play with timed drawings, sun prints, art about the seasons, and other ways you can show how time flies...or doesn't.

**ART THROUGH THE AGES** (Week 4 PM): Hop in our time machine as we discover the fascinating history of art! Students will be introduced to a variety of art movements and their historical time periods, making artworks inspired by famous art from each time.

**OVER THE RAINBOW: EXPLORING COLOR** (Week 4 PM): What is color, and how do artists use it? In this vibrant new class, students will make art in a variety of media that explores color in light and pigment, and the power of colors to affect our feelings and perceptions.

### AGES 9-12

**THE ARTIST IN NATURE** (Week 2 AM): We are delighted to again offer a week of Summer Art Camp at Rutgers Gardens, where students will discover the many connections between art and nature. Painting outdoors has been an important tradition since the time of the Impressionists, and like them, students in this class will use the beauty of nature and sunlight as their inspiration. **\*\*This class takes place at Rutgers Gardens (112 Ryders Lane). Registrants are encouraged to take the companion afternoon class "eARTh Art" for a full-day at the Gardens. Transportation between the Zimmerli and the Gardens is not provided.\*\***

**eARTh Art** (Week 2 PM): Throughout history, people have used art to document and explore the natural world. More recently, artists have created works that call attention to environmental issues like global warming and pollution. Students in this class will make art that considers the relationship between humans and the earth through paintings, drawings, and sculpture, while also learning about all that Rutgers Gardens has to offer. **\*\*This class takes place at Rutgers Gardens (112 Ryders Lane). Registrants are encouraged to take the companion morning class "The Artist in Nature" for a full-day at the Gardens. Transportation between the Zimmerli and the Gardens is not provided.\*\***

## **AGES 11-14**

**SHADOW AND LINE: SECRETS OF DRAWING** (Week 1 AM): By learning its fundamental elements, students will discover the possibilities of drawing in this fun and engaging skill-building class. Throughout the week, students will explore a variety of drawing materials, such as charcoal and pastels.

**PAINTING WITH THE MASTERS** (Week 1 PM): Learn the principles of drawing and painting while studying such famous artists as Vincent Van Gogh, Henri Matisse, Georgia O’Keeffe, and many more. You’ll explore how these artists use style, color, and light, and then apply it to their own work.

**DESIGN BY HAND** (Week 2 AM): You don’t need a computer to do great graphic design! Learn about logo and pattern design, illustration, and other elements that will help you put your own unique style out into the world. Students will also explore text-based art.

**PUPPETRY WORKSHOP** (Week 2 PM): Explore the amazing world of puppets as you work to design, sew, and decorate puppets in this fun and dynamic class. Students learn how to carve Styrofoam, build forms with papier-mâché, and sew felt, creating a durable keepsake that will last for years to come.

**PRINTMAKING** (Week 3 AM): This class introduces students to the fascinating art of printmaking, from start to finish, and how it is used for both artistic and everyday purposes. Students will experiment with a variety of printmaking techniques.
